

PET EMERGENCY CHECKLIST: BE PREPARED FOR ANYTHING

From natural disasters to sudden illnesses, having a well-thought-out emergency plan can save your pet's life. Use this checklist to ensure you and your pets are ready to handle any emergency!





STEP 1: CONTACT INFORMATION AND MEDICAL RECORDS

Keep a list o	f emergency	contacts read	ily accessi	ible, i	includi	ng:
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- ☐ Veterinarian's office number and after-hours emergency clinics
- ☐ Animal poison control hotline
- ☐ Nearby friends or family who can assist in an emergency

Maintain up-to-date medical records and store copies securely with this checklist. Ensure your pet always has proper identification.

- ☐ Proof of vaccinations and a copy of the pet's medical history
- □ Collar with ID tags including your name, phone number and address
- ☐ Recent photo of your pet
- ☐ Pet health insurance customer and policy information
- □ Up-to-date microchip information (e.g. number, name, and number of the microchip company)

STEP 2: ESSENTIALS

Keep a supply of essential items ready to go in case of evacuations

- ☐ Food and water for at least three days stored in airtight containers
- ☐ Portable food and water dishes
- ☐ Leash, harness or carrier for safe transport
- ☐ Evacuation plan for you and your pet
- ☐ Poop disposal bags, kitty litter, and travel-size litter box
- ☐ A supply of flea, tick, and heartworm preventatives



STEP 3: PET FIRST AID KIT THAT INCLUDES:

- □ Small flashlight □ Antibiotic ointment
- □ Exam gloves □ Blunt tip scissors
- ☐ Gauze pads ☐ Thermometer and lubricating jelly
- \square Sterile rinse solution \square Emergency thermal blanket
